Standing for Truth in a Post-Truth Culture “Ideologies Are At War”

II Cor. 10:3-5; Eph. 6:10-18

Key idea: “Ideas have _____!”

1. That God truly gives all people inalienable rights is the “idea” that is the foundation for America’s freedom. Genesis 1:27
2. The Post-Truth ideology that feelings and personal preference are more important than facts or reality, will make America weak in resisting committed ideologies.

Misquoted verse: Mt. 7:1 = “Judge not....”

3. An example: Nazi Germany
 - 1) German universities attacked biblical authority.
 - 2) Adolf Hitler’s evil idea of a master race.
 - 3) Without the foundation of biblical truth, the German people accepted it.
4. Christ-followers are automatically involved in this conflict.
II Cor. 10:5

5. We must engage in the conflict with a Christian worldview as our ideology. I Peter 3:15a
 - 1) We are to stand against the devil’s schemes. Eph. 6:11
 - 2) We must stand with the truth. 6:14
 - 3) We must use spiritual weapons. 6:12
 - 4) We honor Christ by respecting the human dignity of others.
